Government ITIs

The Government ITIs at Koppal and Belgaum developed under Public-Private Partnership by the Government and Bhuruka Welfare has received an encouraging response with a good number of students joining during this academic year. The Management Committee has consented to construct a new building.

SKILL TRAINING

Tailoring

Besides running two tailoring centres at Hothpet and Sagar, an embroidery training centre has been started at Hothpet in Shahapur Taluq. At present there are 18 girls in the 20-day course for the development of embroidery skills.

Computer Centre

A well equipped computer centre is being started for the benefit of rural youth at Talkad in Mysore District. The centre will also run the regular vocational training programmes.

COMMUNITY ORGANIZATION

Shramadhana

To create environmental awareness, seedlings were planted around the Government Schools at Moodala Koppalu and Honnenahalli on Independence Day. School children, teachers, School Betterment Committee members and villagers participated in this programme.

Distribution of Plant Seedlings

2000 saplings of various varieties including neem, teak, hercules, silver, tamarind and jack fruit were distributed to SHG members in collaboration with Social Forest Department, K.R. Pet.

HEALTH

Federation Meeting

Revolving Fund

5 SHGs promoted by Prabudhan Rural Development Trust have received Revolving Funds of Rs. 5,000/- each from the Women and Child Development Department, K.R. Pet.

Accounting workshop

10 SHG groups participated in the one-day workshop on books maintenance, loan repayment and utilization of loans conducted by State Bank of Mysore.

Bank Loan

State Bank of Mysore at T Narsipur has sanctioned a loan of Rs.9,00,000/- to five self help groups started by Bhuruka Welfare. Till today, 9 SHGs have received Rs.15,00,000/- under the Bank Linkage Loan Programme.
